BIHAR IS THE FASTEST GROWING INDIAN STATE BASED ON TEXTILE & LEATHER, AGRICULTURE AND MULTIPLE INDUSTRIAL SECTORS.

Bihar enjoys a unique geographic advantage because of its proximity to the vast markets of Eastern, Northern and North-east India domestically and Nepal as its international neighbor, with easy access to Bangladesh and Bhutan. The state is well connected to the rest of India with 5,421 km dense network of National Highways and a Rail network of 3,794 km. The state has an international airport in Bodh Gaya (GAY) and a domestic airport in Patna (PAT) and Darbhanga (DBR), with 4 other Indian airports near the state's borders in West Bengal, Jharkhand and UP. The National Waterway-1 (NW-1) also passes through the state.

The Golden Quadrilateral Highway passes through the districts of Kaimur, Sasaram, Aurangabad, Gaya, and Patna, connecting the state to major metro cities in the country. The new business opportunities in Bihar are plenty as the Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor passes through the state, providing access to ports in East India such as Kolkata and Haldia, to raw material sources, and mineral reserves in the neighboring states.

The state has identified Food Processing, IT & Electronics, and Textiles & Leather as its high-priority sectors. Food processing, dairy, sugar, manufacturing, and healthcare are some of the fast-growing industries in the state in the state to attract investment opportunities in Bihar.

Bihar has developed industrial park and civil infrastructure, offering land at competitive rates for long and short term lease, with all amenities present for accelerated commissioning of operations for business investors.
